



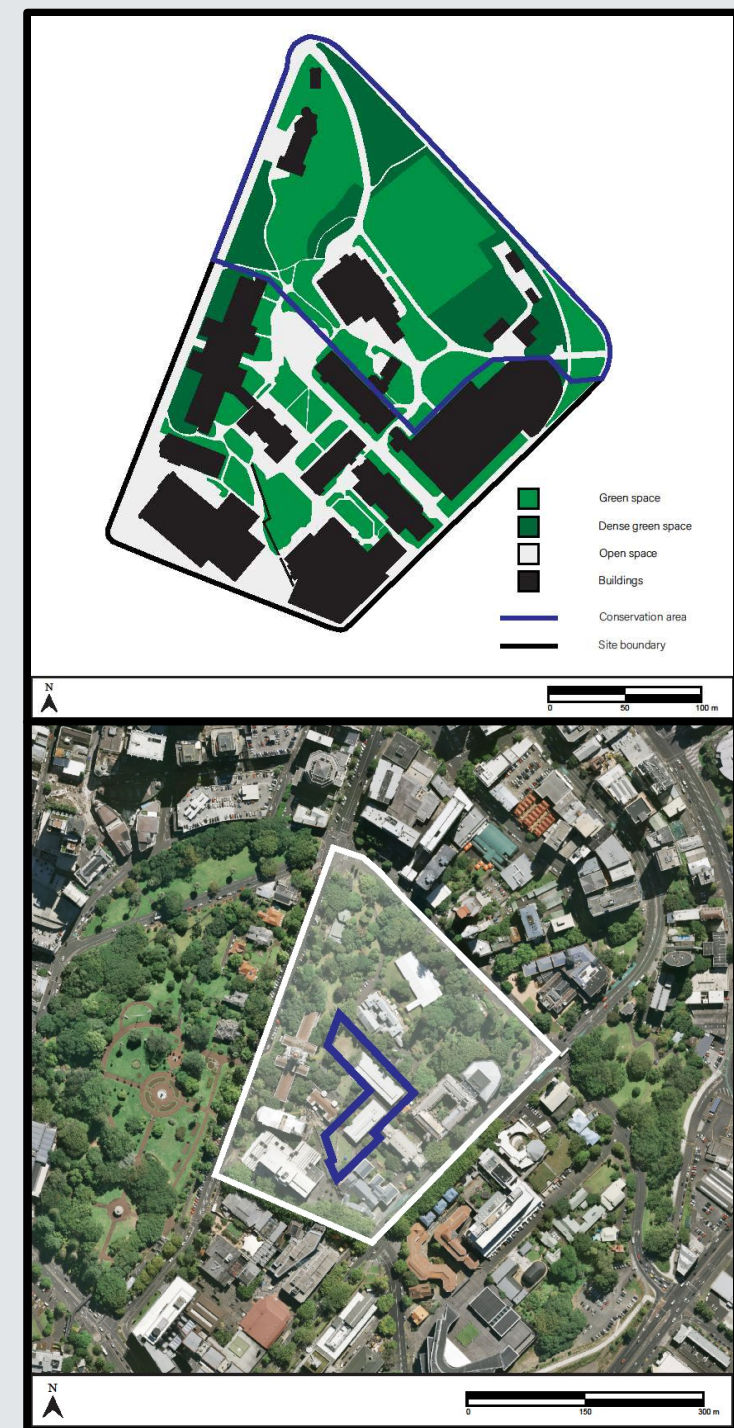
University of Auckland Campus Center Redevelopment

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Site Analysis

- Historical Character
- Temporary Buildings lead to physical and visual disjointedness
- Large sections of site zoned for conservation and heritage
- Center of site has desirable slopes
- Uneven distribution of green space between north & south
- Shared paths are convoluted & uncomfortable

Improve open space connections

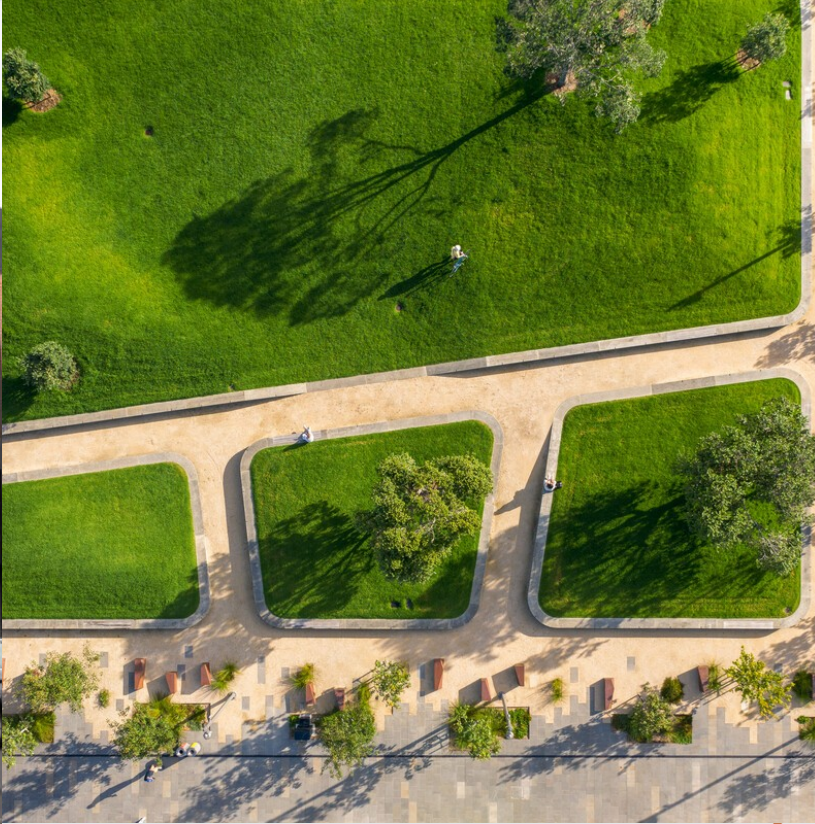

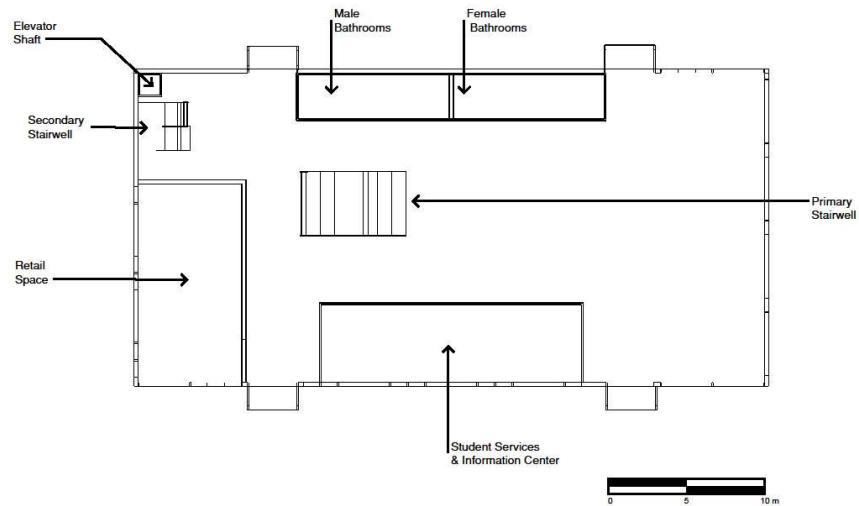
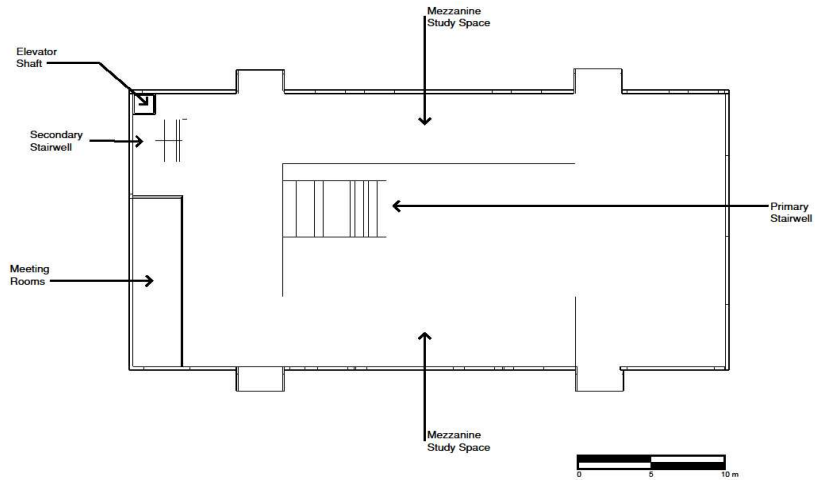
